Why We Host Gatherings

- To increase awareness and understanding of our mission and work in Fresno
- In attempts to create a broader volunteer and donor base
- Encourage dedicated ENP champions to connect with others to raise funds
- Deepen understanding of Fresno both in terms of assets and challenges

Our Goal

- To host 30 "ENP Gathering: Take Part in Changing Our Community" events in homes, churches, offices throughout Fresno in the next 6 months
- Increase the monthly donor base with 20 new monthly donors and 40 one-time gifts

Our Vision

- Host 60 minute gatherings focused on building relationships through intentional and authentic friendship
- Continue to maintain our grassroots outreach approach of informal and interactive gatherings

How to Host an ENP Gathering

- Choose a date, time, and location [preferably a home]
- Choose a theme or context for your gathering, examples: geographic (Tower, NW Fresno, etc.) or an area of interest (economic development, education, etc.)
- Contact Tianna Arredondo at <u>tianna@everyneighborhood.org</u> to coordinate the calendar with the ENP Team - Tianna will also follow up with you to prepare information and answer any questions
- Create a list of 10 30 invitees and begin inviting people
- Create Paper or Digital Invite we will provide you with a Facebook image and can help set up the Facebook page
- Follow up with reminder phone calls or texts a week prior to the event, as well as a day before the gathering

Event Set-Up

Step 1: Set up the room for the gathering

- Arrange handouts (ENP will provide) to be ready for handout
- You will need at T.V. available and set-up ahead of time to present using our PowerPoint a
- Try to make room free of outside noise
- Make sure food and drinks are easily accessible on the outside areas of the presentation room

Step 2: Welcome Guests

- Place name tags and sign-in sheet, we will provide, at the entrance of your gathering
- Decide whether you will hand out ENP materials before or after presentation and designate someone to help while you present

Step 3: Designate someone to assist with the event

- Make sure, or designate someone to ensure every guest signs in
- Have someone keep a timer on their phone who can let you know when to switch gears and close the gathering

Step 4: Follow the event schedule on the following page

 Please be sure to follow the time markers and talking points to best ensure a 60 minute gathering

Step 5: Pass out and collect giving cards, evaluations and sign in sheets

- · Pass out ENP materials
- Ask guests to fill in the event evaluation and giving cards so we may connect with them
- Please leave 5-10 minutes for this portion of the event
