

Audio Drive Tour begins from The Revue Coffee Shop (620 E Olive Ave, Fresno, CA 93728). Park in the back parking lot or for additional parking on Broadway St.

TRACK 1 / BEFORE LEAVING WELCOME & INTRODUCTION - RANDY WHITE (4:50)

After intro track head west (Left) on E Olive Ave toward N Palm Ave

TRACK 2 / ONCE ON OLIVE JOB DEVELOPMENT - AP AMOUR (2:02)

Neighborhood Thrift will be on your right hand side of Olive Ave past Wishon Ave.

Right onto N Palm Ave (first light) - 0.3 mi

Left onto E McKinley Ave - 1.2 mi



Left onto N Golden State Blvd - 0.3 mi

Sharp **Right** onto **W Pine Ave** - 243 ft

TRACK 4 / IN SANDS HOTEL MOTEL DRIVE - RICHARD BURRELL (3:16) Pull into Sands Hotel - Circle in and drive out

East on W Pine Ave toward Golden State Blvd - 243 ft

Slight Right onto N Golden State Blvd - 0.4 mi

Right onto W Olive Ave - 0.5 mi

Left onto N Parkway Dr - 0.5 mi

Left onto Belmont Ave - 0.6 mi

TRACK 5 / PASSING ROEDING PARK PRAYING FOR OUR CITY - KATHY MCLLHARGEY (1:29)

At the traffic circle, take the 3rd exit and stay on Belmont Ave, continue east - 1.3 mi

Right onto N Calaveras St - 0.7 mi



Slight Right to stay on on N Calaveras St crossing Divisadero St.

Left onto M St - 486 ft

TRACK 7 / ON M ST

ASSOC. OF MINISTRY HOUSES - SARAH CUEVAS (0:49) The Pink House is on your right hand side in the parking lot across from First Presbyterian Church.

Right at 1st cross street onto E Stanislaus St - 400 ft

Head northwest on L St toward Calaveras St - 1,132 ft

Right to stay on **L St** - 131 ft

Left at 1st cross street onto E Divisadero St - 1,053 ft

TRACK 8 / ON DIVISADERO ST CULTURAL ARTS DISTRICT - CRAIG SCHARTON (2:14)

Left onto Fulton St - 0.3 mi



WALK/STOP RECOMMENDATION Cultural Arts Park - 1615 Fulton St

Right onto Tuolumne St - 0.2 mi

TRACK 9 / ON TUOLUMNE ST HISTORY OF RAILROAD - KEVIN ENNS-REMPEL (1:43)

Head southwest on Tuolumne St - 0.5 mi

Left onto E St, Continue to follow A St - 1,043 ft

Right onto Fresno St - 797 ft

Left onto Collins Ave - 987 ft

TRACK 10 / ON COLLINS AVE PRAYER WALKS - BT LEWIS (2:17) Rising Star, Pastor Lewis' church, will be on your left.

Left at the 2nd cross street onto Tulare St - 0.5 mi



Right onto F St - 0.4 mi

Fresno Rescue Mission will be on your left and right side past San Benito St. Make a U-Turn after the Mission and head back.

Head back northwest on G St - 0.3 mi

Right onto Ventura St - 0.4mi

Left onto Van Ness Ave - 591 ft

TRACK 13 / ON VAN NESS AVE

Jake is co-CEO of Bitwise Industries. Bitwise will be on your right hand side after Mono St. If you like tech this is your place.

Northwest on Van Ness Ave toward Inyo St - .3mi

Right onto Kern St - 801 ft

Right onto M St - 233 ft

Left at 1st cross street onto Inyo St - 1,194 ft

TRACK 14 / ON INYO ST CIVIC CENTER- CRAIG SCHARTON (2:45)

Left onto P St - 0.5 mi

Left on Merced St - 801 ft

Left at the 2nd cross street onto N St - 476 ft

Left at the 1st cross street onto Fresno St - 0.6 mi

WALK/STOP RECOMMENDATION Eaton Plaza - 2400 Fresno St



Right onto E Illinois Ave - 571 ft

Left onto N Mariposa St - 0.4 mi

Right onto Belmont Ave - 0.6 mi



Left onto N Bond St - 620 ft

World Impact Hidalgo Community Center is located on your right hand side of Bond St (646 N Bond St).

Right onto E Harvey Ave - .3 mi

Right onto N 5th St - 305 ft

Left at 1st cross street onto E Thomas Ave - 656 ft

Right onto N 7th St/N Millbrook Ave - 679 ft

Slight right onto N Millbrook Ave - 384 ft

N Millbrook Ave turns slightly left and becomes N 6th St - 0.7 mi



Right onto E Kerckhoff Ave - 0.4 mi

Left onto S 1st St - 0.3 mi

Left onto E Ventura Ave - 1 mi

Right onto S Cedar Ave - 0.5 mi



Left onto E Butler Ave - 0.4 mi

Left onto S Maple Ave - 0.6 mi

Right onto E Kings Canyon Rd - 0.5 mi



Left onto S Chestnut Ave - 0.5 mi

Right onto E Tulare Ave - 0.8 mi

Right onto S Helm Ave - 0.3 mi

Pull into Trolley Creek Park at the end of Helm. Make U-Turn.

Left at 1st cross street onto N Peach Ave - 0.7 mi

TRACK 21 / ON PEACH AVE ENGAGING SCHOOLS - ARTIE PADILLA (1:21)

As you turn left on Peach, you will see Easterby Elementary on your right hand side.

Left to merge onto CA-180W - 2.26 mi

ECONOMICS AND CHURCH - ASHLEY SWEARENGIN (1:20)

Take the **Yosemite exit toward 41 N** and merge onto **CA-41N** - 1.39 mi

Take exit 129 for McKinley Ave - 1,312 ft

Right onto E McKinley Ave - 0.3 mi

Right at 2nd cross street onto N Fresno St - 1,224 ft

Right at on E Weldon Ave - 1,316 ft

TRACK 23 / ON WELDON AVE

REFUGEES IN FRESNO - ZACH DARRAH (2:00) As you go under the highway, you will see Fresno Interdenominational Refugee Ministry off to your right hand side.

Left onto N Angus St - 0.3 mi
